

WELCOME TO BROOKVIEW!

TOURNAMENT AND GROUP OUTING POLICIES

Brookview is a moderately difficult golf course with water in play on 14 holes, fairly small greens, and several tree-lined fairways. We welcome groups of all sizes for tournaments on the 18-hole Regulation Course or the Par 3. Brookview's banquet area, deck, gazebo, and patio also provide a great setting for food and fun either before or after golf. Whether you're planning a formal tournament or a casual group outing, Brookview staff will work with you in every way to make your event a success.

The following course policies are intended to be fair and reasonable guidelines for the operation and control of all Brookview facilities. Please read and review them with all members of your tournament/group outing committee. If you have questions, contact the Golf Manager at 763-512-2305.

GENERAL RULES

- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.
- **No metal spikes** are allowed. Alternative spikes can be purchased in the Brookview Golf Shop.
- Only foursomes are allowed (**no fivesomes**).
- No walk-alongs or ride-alongs are permitted on the course.
- Special arrangements for score sheets, event stakes, tables, beverages, etc, must be made eight days in advance.
- Coolers, thermos bottles, and outside beverage containers of any kind are not allowed on the premises. No food or beverages, other than those purchased at Brookview, are permitted on the course.
- The sale of retrieved golf balls by outside agents is not permitted.

RATES, RESERVATIONS, AND PAYMENT

- Brookview requires a **guaranteed** number of players and carts (if requested) for any tournament or group outing.
- Groups must be scheduled and paid for in foursomes only.
- **Full payment** of all green fees and golf cart fees must be made eight days before the event. See enclosed fee sheet for current pricing.
- Brookview accepts payment by cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover.

GOLF CARTS

- Golf carts may be reserved for golfers only.
- If more carts are required than available, they must be obtained from an outside cart company at the current rental rate. Reservation of extra carts is based on availability.

TEE TIMES

- Organizers must inform all tournament players of their tee times.

- Players must arrive 20 minutes prior to their tee time.
- A Starter Sheet is enclosed for your convenience. Please have Starter Sheets available at the course before the first group arrives.

PACE OF PLAY

Groups must keep up with pace of play or risk forfeiting the opportunity for future outings at Brookview.

To maintain an acceptable pace of play (four hours and 20 minutes for 18 holes), we suggest a *Scramble Format* for tournaments or group outings. In a Scramble, all players tee off and each foursome chooses the best ball to play forward. This continues until the hole is finished. The Scramble is a good format for groups with players of varying abilities.

REFUNDS/DELAYS DUE TO RAIN OR UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

If the decision to cancel, delay, or reschedule a tournament or group outing is made by the Golf Manager, refunds/rain checks are made available at the discretion of the Golf Manager.

SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF PRIVILEGES

Any person may be denied admittance to or use of any Brookview facility for drunkenness, disregard of general policies, fraud (using facilities without paying fees), abusive language to employees or customers, improper attire (shirts must be worn on the premises), vandalism of property, conduct detrimental to health or well-being of others, refusing to obey rules of behavior at each facility, intentionally driving golf balls off golf course property (such as onto highway from driving range), the abuse of any privilege granted with a patron card (such as letting someone else use it).

No refunds will be granted for loss of benefits due to suspension or revocation of privileges.



GROUP OUTING INFORMATION



GATHERING AREAS, FOOD, AND BEVERAGES

Make a day of it and extend your group golf outing to include breakfast, lunch, or dinner in the relaxing atmosphere of Brookview Golf Course. Brookview's banquet area, deck, gazebo, and patio provide a great setting for food and fun either before or after golf, and Brookview's top-notch catering service provides an array of menu items sure to satisfy appetites whetted by a day on the course.

PATIO AND DECK RENTAL

Groups wanting to gather before or after golfing are invited to enjoy Brookview's other amenities. The patio is equipped with two gas grills and can accommodate small to mid-sized groups (up to 50 people). The patio and deck combination, which includes a covered gazebo, is perfect for larger groups (more than 50 people). See enclosed fee sheet for current pricing.

COMMUNITY CENTER WILLOW ROOM

If you're interested in an indoor room, Brookview Community Center's Willow Room is available for rent and provides access to the patio and deck. You can rent all three areas for an extra fee.

The Willow Room accommodates 215 people and is equipped with a caterer's kitchen. Reservations must be made in advance through the Golden Valley Park and Recreation Department (763-512-2345).

BEVERAGES

Groups using Brookview facilities, including the patio and deck, are encouraged to purchase all non-alcoholic beverages (soft drinks, lemonade, ice tea, etc) and 3.2 beer from the Brookview Grill.

Groups using the Community Center's Willow Room are required to use either the Brookview Grill's beverage service or the contract beverage service for the City of Golden Valley. See enclosed fee sheet for current pricing.

BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

Pop and 3.2 beer is available for purchase at the Brookview Grill and on the course, weather permitting. If you would like pop/beer available to your group on the course, you must make arrangements in advance with the Golf Manager. Tournament members are not allowed to provide their own pop/beer carts.

CONCESSIONS

Brookview retains all concession rights to any and all food or beverages for consumption on or around the premises.

CATERING/FOOD

Brookview Grill offers catering and meal options for group events, including breakfasts, box lunches, appetizers, and des-

serts. Grilled menu selections, such as hamburgers, hot dogs, chicken breasts, and steaks, along with a variety of side dishes, are also available.

A 20-guest minimum is required for catering services, and menu selections must be made eight days in advance. Final guest counts are required no later than three days before the event.
